Lithgow Small Arms Factory Museum	Building Works	The project will have two main outcomes, it will provide longevity to the building structure by treating the rust and raised painted surfaces which as been building on many of the external steel window frames. Also, by restoring the steel frame sand applying a 'biscuit' colour will lift the aesthetics of the building. A number of window frames are showing large gaps with the brickwork which is letting in moisture/dust, especially on the northern face of the building.	\$10,083
Lithgow State Mine Heritage Park and Museum	Building Works	The project is to repaint the roofs of the three buildings to ensure ongoing conservation and protection of building interiors and contents.	\$6,480
Woodford Academy	Building Works	This project is to fix roof leaks and repair timber ceiling boards in Attic Room; carry out minor repairs to timber windows in rooms to ensure that can be opened; refix all loose floor boards in rooms S23 and S24; missing and damaged plaster lath finishes to be repaired in rooms S22 and S23 , S27, 28 and 29 ; stonemason to replace worn and damaged stone thresholds to prevent entry of vermin to doors of Rooms S27 and S28; carry out roof inspection, for water entry from flashing at junction of south wing and west extension; replace deteriorated downpipes on south and north elevations in galvanised steel, fixing brackets to match existing profiles and ensure downpipes are connected to stormwater system.	\$12,000
Old Courthouse Museum	Building Works	This project is to supply and install insulation in both the ceiling and underfloor in order to improve visitor and volunteer comfort.	\$3,700

Armidale Folk Museum	Building Assessment	To engage a consultant to identify and report on building improvement needs, including but not limited to, thermal window dressings and control of daylight/temperature through skylights, reducing the gap tolerance around exterior doors and windows, efficient lighting systems and accessible entry.	n/a
Eskbank House	Building Assessment	To engage a consultant to identify and report on building improvement needs, including but not limited to, RH and temp monitoring, quality of available collection storage, quality of available showcases and collection security in available storage and display conditions.	n/a
NSW Lancers Memorial Museum	Building Assessment	To engage a consultant to identify and report on building improvement needs, including but not limited to, checking that roof repairs are sound with no further leaks, checking windows and window frames, checking adequacy of window blinds.	n/a
Schaeffer House	Building Assessment	To engage a consultant to identify and report on building improvement needs, including but not limited to, building condition overall, energy efficiency of building, effectiveness of Stormwater dispersal, sub floor and termite controls and exterior paint finishes.	n/a
