Living Treasures: Masters of Australian Craft

Helen Britton is the tenth artist to be named as a Living Treasure: Master of Australian Craft. Helen is a multidisciplinary Australian artist based in Munich, Germany. Her practice includes jewellery, sculpture, drawings, stencils and installations, and is informed by popular culture, threatened traditions, environmental destruction and human anxiety.

This series continues to have an impact on generations of artists and art lovers across Australia and internationally.
